Pridetronics participates in the FIRST Robotics Competition (FRC), VEX Robotics Competition (VRC), where we compete with teams from around the world. We also compete in the Arizona Robotics League (ARL) and Futureshaper Robotics Competition sponsored by Honeywell and the Arizona Diamondbacks. Our accomplishments in FIRST include: competing in the FIRST World Championships in 2016 and Houston Championship in 2018. In 2019, we finished in 2nd place at the Arizona West Regionals, where we won the Gracious Professionalism Award. In 2018 and 2022 Pridetronics mentors have won the Woodie Flowers Finalist Award. Finalists are then considered for the Woodie Flowers Award at the World Championships. Woodie Flowers Finalists are nominated by the students they mentor. Our FRC team has also competed in the Arizona State Championship for the past 8 consecutive years. Additionally, we have been recognized by the robotics community through judged awards including the Engineering Award for our use of a team contract which coordinates the various teams such as build, programming and electrical in building the robot. In 2022 we won the Arizona Robotics League qualifier and was a finalist in the championship. In 2023 our VEX team had also won a Future shapers competition.

Robotics competitions teach copious amounts of technical and management skills, such as Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Engineering, 3D Design, Programming and Business skills.
